

## IANA Stewardship Process: CRISP Team

- Consolidated RIR IANA Stewardship Proposal (CRISP) Team
  - 15 members: 2 community reps + 1 RIR staff / region



## Numbers community priorities



# Components of the Proposal

IANA function stability & reliability

ICANN to continue as the IANA Numbering Services Operator, with provisions for orderly transition to another operator should such need arise

RIR to establish SLA with IANA operator

Replace role of NTIA with the RIRs: RIRs to establish an SLA with the IANA Numbering Services Operator

Community-based Review committee Establish a community-based Review Committee to review the performance of IANA Numbering Services and provide advice to the RIRs

IPRs with the community

Intellectual property rights (IPR) related to the IANA services stay with the community

Components of the Proposal

IANA function stability & reliability

RIR to establish SLA with IANA operator

Community-based Review committee

IPRs with the community

 Intellectual property rights (IPR) related to the IANA services stay with the community finalised

- Termination clause: Either party can terminate agreement
- SLA development to take place in public
  A areed!





Respect for principles agreed to in the CRISP proposal

#### **CRISP** work post submission

- Present, communicate and "champion" proposal
- Ensure proposal integrity
  - Many moving parts in this process
  - IPR, Termination clause, SLA, Review committee
  - Review of and feedback on other community proposal drafts
- Actively participate in overal IANA stewardship transition process
  - Representing the Numbers proposal
  - Coordination with other communities
  - Ensuring we meet transition timelines

#### Where are we now?

All three communities finished their proposals

- The ICG has completed its combined proposal
  - waiting for CCWG-Accountability
- CCWG-Accountability target date end January
  - Very challenging timeline
  - Includes approvals of all SO/ACs
- Complete proposal submission to NTIA end January
- CCWG-Accountability submission to NTIA end January

#### Next steps - finalisation

#### Intellectual Property Rights


- We want framework finalised before submission to the NTIA
  - IANAPLAN has produced a high level decription
  - CRISP has published its minimum requirements
  - · It's time to finalise this across all three communities!

#### Next steps - implementation

Implementation! (Yay - can we go home now?)

- Tentative talks with other parties
  - Operational communities
  - RIRs
  - ICANN (etc.)
- Different parties have different roles
  - RIRs to implement
  - CRISP team to ensure proposal is respected
    - More of an "auditor role"
