F. Discussion of open policy proposals (1)

- 2014-03
 - “Remove Multihoming Requirement for AS Number Assignments”
 - in review phase since Nov 2014
 - no consensus so far, way forward not clear
 - * item of dispute: “max 1000 ASn per organization” clause
 - * some sort of “slow-down” mechanism is needed
 - * AGM voting item: bring back per-AS charge ⇒ voted: NO
 - proposers have decided to withdraw
 - ... which sparked renewed interest on the mailing list
 - new volunteer stepped up: Nick Hilliard

F. Discussion of open policy proposals (2)

- 2015-04
 - “RIPE Resource Transfer Policies”
 - not that much discussion seen on the list
 - * main discussion point: new restrictions on re-transfers
 - Impact Analysis has just been posted
 - * uncovered wording issue (intention clear, wording not)
 - short presentation by Erik Bais
 - then Q&A, and feedback from the room

F. Discussion of open policy proposals (3)

- 2015-05
 - “Revision of Last /8 Allocation Criteria”
 - fairly heated discussion on list
 - * two camps: “must preserve addresses for future participants” vs. “give (me) more space”
 - * unclear whether consensus can be reached
